Mrs. Jennifer Tillotson is a native of Vicksburg. She and her husband have four sons and seven grandsons. She also was one of the assistant directors of the Warren Central High School spring musicals for 15 years as well as accompanist.

She has taught music to children on mission trips to Honduras, China, and Africa. She has also been a teacher/director for the Mississippi Baptist Convention's Summer Music and Arts Camp for many summers. Jennifer is also an active member of the Mississippi Baptist Singing Churchwomen Choir. For five years she has been the Executive Producer of the Miss Mississippi Outstanding Teen Pageant and this year she will serve as Co-Producer of the Miss Mississippi Competition.

Jennifer serves on the Board of Directors for the Miss Mississippi Corporation and as the secretary for the Executive Board of Mississippi Music Educators Association. She has also been accompanist for several local churches and many state-wide choral groups including the Mississippi Boy Choir and the Mississippi All-State Elementary and Junior High Honor Choirs during her professional career.
